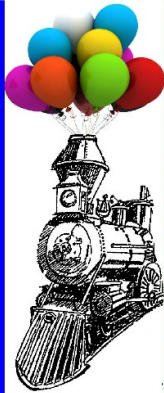

TOUR ITINERARY – SATURDAY 26 MARCH 2016

It is proposed to offer one sightseeing and gourmet tour on Easter Saturday. This tour will operate if there is a minimum of 30 people at a cost of \$18 per person.

Second stop – Loch Ard Gorge – historical site of the “Loch Ard” shipwreck. It has been the location of live performances of “The Tempest”. A spectacular beach on the Shipwreck Coast.

Third stop – Twelve Apostles – iconic tourist spot on the Great Ocean Road, and feature of Australia’s tourism marketing. Arguably the most recognisable tourist destination in Australia alongside Ayers Rock and the Sydney Harbour Bridge.
